Procedure

Requests for transfer of credit must be recommended by your advisor and department graduate committee before forwarding to the office of the College Dean or Director of the School/Center.

Once the Dean/Director's Office has approved the request, it is forwarded to the Graduate College for final review and processing. The transfer documents become part of your permanent Graduate College file. When accepted transfer credit has been posted, you will be able to view it on your Student Center.

To be eligible for transfer, courses must be

- 1. Designated as graduate credit at the institution where taken,
- 2. Letter graded B or better,
- 3. Earned within the past five years,
- 4. Applicable toward a graduate degree at the institution where taken, and
- 5. Earned in courses taught by members of that institution's graduate faculty.

Credits requested for transfer cannot have been used to satisfy requirements for completion of another degree. Courses equivalent to those at Ohio University cannot be transferred for credit and also be taken for credit at Ohio University. Credit is not accepted for courses taken by correspondence.
